**RE: INVITATION TO THE INAUGURATION AND INAUGURAL
TOURNAMENT OF THE SHUTTLE CLUB ASSOCIATION GHANA (SCAG)**

The Ministry of Sport and Recreation (MoSR) extends its compliments and writes in response to your letter dated 6th August 2025 on the above subject.

The Ministry wishes to bring to your attention Sections 3(1), 5, 26 and 27 of the Sports Regulations, 2023 (L.I. 2477) which outlines the requirements and conditions for the establishment and operations of a sporting association or federation. For the avoidance of doubt, Section 3(1) of the Regulations state that *'a person shall not operate as a sports entity unless that person has (a) registered the sports entity with the Authority; and (b) obtained a license to operate the sports entity from the Authority in accordance with regulation 11.*

Section 5 of the Regulations provides that *'the Authority shall not register or license more than one national sports association for a particular sporting discipline'*. Sections 26 and 27 of the Regulations outline the procedure for securing clearance for public sporting events and recreational sporting activities, respectively.

Information available to the Ministry indicate that there already exists a recognised national association for badminton in Ghana.

In view of the foregoing, the Shuttle Club Association, Ghana (SCAG) is hereby directed to contact the Ghana Badminton Association for any assistance or wish to participate in operating within the sport of Badminton in Ghana.

We count on your cooperation in this regard.
